SUBJECT: Industry Based Workload Alignment (IBWA)

1. The Industry Based Workload Alignment System (IBWA) is an Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense (Health Affairs) mandated initiative designed to capture inpatient workload in a process similar to our civilian counterparts. This initiative changes how clinical information for professional inpatient services is collected and reported. Originally directed in 1998, the three Services have been slow to implement this process. This year a tri-Services tiger team was created to oversee testing and implementation with a mandatory timeline of 31 December 2003 for Military Health System wide implementation.
2. Between the months of January and September of this year, the system has undergone final review and Alpha testing, which both took longer than initially anticipated. Admittedly, we did a poor job of informing you of the impending deployment; however, the reality is that a good faith attempt to fully deploy this system must be undertaken by all facilities, both CONUS and OCONUS. COL Doreen Lounsbury discussed the IBWA requirement with your DCCSs at this month's VTC in early October, and LTC Van Coots followed up with email communication with them and will discuss at their 4 November VTC. PASBA has been discussing this with your coders. I do not expect 100% perfect data collection with the initial implementation; but I do expect each facility to do their best to utilize the system in the specified timeline. The current deployment plan (enclosure 1) has been developed taking into account shared CHCS hosts with the Navy and the Air Force, and has been modified in some instances due to JCAHO surveys and problems with the interface between CHCSII and IBWA.
3. Realizing that this system will have an impact on the way we do business, we have attempted to develop the best method for implementing the system, utilizing coders, and minimizing the direct impact on our providers. Based on the Centers for Medicare-Medicaid Services' guidelines as verified by the Unified Biostatistical Utility (UBU), there is a requirement that an attending physician write a note on each inpatient, each day, in order for that workload to be counted. For facilities with no Graduate Medical Education, this simply means that the attending will have to write a brief note on each patient articulating any treatment modalities or procedures performed during rounds that day.

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For facilities with interns, residents, and fellows, the attending will still have to write a note; however, the note can reference the trainee's history, physical, assessment, and plan. The attending can no longer simply write "agree with plan" and then sign the chart. The system will generate an electronic daily round (RNDs) that will have to be appropriately coded.

4. There are several options for ensuring the smooth deployment of this system and in minimizing the initial impact on both the providers and the coders. The system is designed to send a message to the desktop of each attending notifying him/her of an uncoded round. The provider then accesses the ADM module, similar to what is already done on outpatients through KG-ADS, and manually codes the encounter. An alternative that we highly recommend is the use of the superbill (examples at enclosure 2) by the providers. By using the superbill, the provider can quickly check off the appropriate E&M code for the day's round, and the coder can then match the superbill to the day's record of care and appropriately code the encounter; thus, saving the provider that extra administrative step. Your facilities may phase IBWA into full use by starting with one or two clinical services first and then transitioning to all clinical services within 60 days of their implementation date. A detailed milestone plan should be provided to me through LTC Coots. This will show our good faith in attempting to field a viable workload collection system, while at the same time minimizing the impact on your facilities.
